March 27, 2020

CLARK COUNTY COVID-19

Discussion was held regarding COVID-19. County employees in attendance included Sheriff Bart May, Assessor Carrie May, Treasurer Lana Schwartz, Coroner Brenda Laird, County Agent Laurie Small, Emergency Management Director Jill Egan, Road and Bridge Supervisor Darrin May, and Deputy Clerk Treva May. The Stay-at-Home Order will be posted on the public library bulletin board and the county website. Mrs. Egan discussed the COVID-19 Decision Tree and the All-Hazard Mitigation Plan. Discussion also held on body recovery. Sheriff May discussed that personal protective equipment should be worn in such cases. Sheriff May doesn't foresee an issue with the Stay-at-Home Order.

CLARK COUNTY COVID-19 RESPONSE

Commissioner Hillman motioned to extend the county offices' closure to the public from March 25th to April 15th at midnight to coincide with Governor Little's Stay-at-Home Order with each department opening for four set hours each day that will be advertised on the county website. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
