## INTEGRA PAPERLESS BUSINESS SOLUTIONS-QUOTES

Carrie May, Assessor, presented a quote for a new scanner to replace the present one as it isn't reparable for future repairs due to the scanner model being obsolete. She also presented quotes for a microfilm reader. Counties aren't required to possess a microfilm reader, but all microfilm must be scanned. Presently, Clark County has 30 books that require the larger scanner's capabilities. Discussion was held.

Commissioner Hillman motioned to approve the Glued Book Scanning Project through Integra for a total of \$2,564.00. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

### FORENSIC INVESTIGATION

Discussion was held on the Mullen Coughlin Engagement Letter.

Commissioner Ward motioned to proceed with a forensic investigation of the computers, pay the deductible that will be due to the Idaho Counties Risk Management Program (ICRMP), and retain Mullen Coughlin as counsel. Commissioner Hillman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
