WHEREAS, it is a well documented and scientific fact that the grizzly is an uncontrollable and deadly threat to man; and


WHEREAS, certain agencies of the Federal Government may attempt to establish a population of Grizzly Bear in Clark County; and


WHEREAS, the citizens of Clark County have expressed their concerns to the Commissioners of Clark County, State of Idaho, asking for protection; and


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

WHEREAS, the citizens of Clark County have expressed their concerns to the Commissioners of Clark County, State of Idaho, asking for protection; and


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**
