

CLARK COUNTY IDAHO
RESOLUTION NO. 04-24

WHEREAS, the Clark County Board of Commissioners is authorized by the Emergency Communications Act, Idaho Code 31-4803 through 31-4812 to establish a consolidated emergency communication system, with voter approval; and

WHEREAS, at the November 2, 2004, General Election, the voters of Clark County voted on the following question: "Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County be authorized to institute a telephone access line user fee, including wireless and cellular lines, in an amount not greater than one dollar (\$1.00) per month to be used to fund and finance the maintenance and operation of a 911 emergency communication system?", and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Clark County voted in favor of the ballot question by a 73.13% margin, and


WHEREAS, Idaho Code 31-4802(1) defines "Access line" to be any telephone line, trunk line, network access register, dedicated radio signal, or equivalent that provides switched telecommunications access to a consolidated emergency communications system from either a service address or a place of primary use within this state. In the case of wireless technology, each active dedicated telephone number shall be considered a single access line.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Clark County Board of County Commissioners that one dollar (\$1.00) per month shall be assessed against all access lines, including wireless and cellular phones, as an emergency communications fee, for the purpose of maintaining an enhanced 911 system, being purchased with homeland security funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said monthly fee shall commence as of January 1, 2005.


