

RESOLUTION NO. 98-06

It has been unanimously approved and agreed upon by Clark County Commissioners to acquire the use of and finance through First Security Bank, N.A., the generally described as NEW CATERPILLAR 140H MOTOR GRADER costing \$177,999.00 for a term of 5 years, at 5.49 % annual percentage rate. The first annual payment of \$18,862.00 will be paid in advance, followed by 5 annual payments of \$18,862.00 and 1 final payment of \$121,500.00.

Charles R. Vadnais has been authorized to sign the necessary documents on behalf of Clark County.



