

CLARK COUNTY IDAHO
RESOLUTION NO. 04-25

WHEREAS, houndstongue (*Cynoglossum officinale* L.) is a new invasive weed species in Clark County and is capable of rapid infestation; and

WHEREAS, houndstongue is a poisonous plant to sheep, cattle and horses; and


WHEREAS, Idaho Department of Agriculture Cost-Share funding would become available to assist in it's control;

WHEREAS, I.C. §22-2406 gives the Board of County Commissioners authority to designate weeds noxious in the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners for Clark County in its capacity as County Control Authority, do hereby resolve houndstongue (*Cynoglossum officinale* L.) be declared a noxious weed in Clark County.

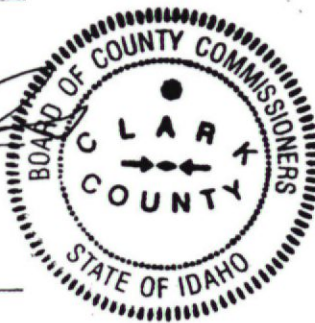
