WHEREAS I.C.31-871(2)(b) says semi-permanent records shall be kept for not less than five years after date of issuance; and

WHEREAS I.C. 31-871(2)(d) says records may be destroyed by resolution of the board of county commissioners after audit and the advise of the prosecuting attorney; and

WHEREAS Searle, Hart and Associates conducted an audit of the County and presented it to the Board of County Commissioners on February 13, 2006; and

WHEREAS Prosecutor for Clark County, Craig Simpson has advised the Clerk that records can be destroyed following Idaho Code;

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED that the following semi-permanent records be destroyed upon the passing of this resolution:

Voter Cancellations from 1997, 1999 and 2000 Employer Payroll Benefit Records from 1980,1980,1985, 1986, 1987, 1988,1989 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997
