

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

CLARK COUNTY, IDAHO

OCTOBER 13, 1987

The Board met this day in regular session, Present were Commissioners J. Albert Laird, George H. Whittaker, and Charles R. Vadnais; Prosecuting Attorney Jack Voshell and Deputy Stevan Thompson; and Clerk JoAnn S. Tavenner.

MINUTES

Motion be Commissioner Vadnais seconded by Commissioner Whittaker that the minutes of the last Board meeting on September 14, 1987, be approved as written.

TRANSFER COUNTY LICENSE

A request having been received for transfer of County liquor license. It was moved by Commissioner Whittaker seconded by Commissioner Vadnais, unanimous that the request of transfer from Joseph C. Wilson to Sharon K. Vadnais (at Sage Bar) be accepted.

SPENCER WATER

Richard Horne, Department of Health & Welfare, met with the Board and informed them the drinking water at Spencer is contaminated. He stated that the City of Spencer was notified by letter, but he has not received a response. He said he would send out two notices; first would be on violation and second pre-enforcement hearing and then the state would take over. Horne said he suggested where the City has no money that 4 or 5 people group together and drill a well.

MEDICAL INDIGENT CASE APPEALED

Pat Bennett listed Medical expenses he is paying for and requested that the Commission reconsider his claim. After a short discussion it was decided that the Attorney Stevan Thompson would check with Health & Welfare and see if this case qualifies for payment under Senate Bill 1182.

JACOBY ROAD

Eldridge Russell, Road Foreman met with the Board and reported that they have installed cattleguards on both ends of the Jacoby road bringing it up to qualifications required under County Road System.

QUARTERLY REPORTS

The Board reviewed the Sheriff's and Clerk's quarterly reports. Motion by Commissioner Vadnais seconded by Commissioner Whittaker unanimous that reports be accepted as reported.

## COUNTY LIQUOR LICENSE

A liquor license application was reviewed by the Board. Motion by Commissioner Vadnais seconded by Commissioner Whittaker, unanimous, that the Pioneer Cafe & Bar beer and liquor license be approved and issued.

## BRIDGE INSPECTION REPORTS

Clint Kingsford, County Engineer, met with the Commission and reported that Pleasant Valley Bridge and the Railroad Bridge at Monida should be closed or repaired due to the liability to the County. Kingsford said piers and caps on Pleasant Valley bridge were deteriorating and it would cost around 20 or 25 thousand dollars to replace. He recommended that Pleasant Valley be closed within the next 5 years and the Railroad bridge within 10 years.

## AMBULANCE

Ernest Sill reported to the Board that the Lions Club had 16 people signed up to take the EMT classes which would start the first week in November. He said he estimates it would cost around \$14,000.00 per year to operate with volunteer EMT's. He said the Lion's have two pagers which are about 2 years old and four radio's which would need replaced in about 2 years.

The group discussed fee's and it was suggested that fee be raised to \$100.00 or \$120.00 per run.

Sill stated he would see the Board gets a copy of the revenue and expenditures on the ambulance for the past two years.
