

CLARK COUNTY IDAHO
RESOLUTION NO. 04-06

WHEREAS, the Idaho State Legislature has amended Idaho Code § 23-307 to provide for the sale or delivery of any alcoholic liquor in, on or from the premises of any state liquor store or distributing station in a county on any Sunday which does not fall on Christmas Day, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners may by resolution allow for the sale or delivery of any alcoholic liquor in, on or from the premises of any state liquor store or distributing station in the county on any Sunday which does not fall on Christmas Day so long as the resolution remains in effect, and;

WHEREAS, allowing Sunday sale or delivery of alcoholic liquor in Clark County would benefit local merchants and provide increased revenue to the county, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Clark County Commissioners have opted to allow through resolution Sunday alcohol sales to occur in Clark County pursuant to Idaho Code § 23-307.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that sale or delivery of any alcoholic liquor in, on, or from the premises of any state liquor store or distributing station in the county on any Sunday which does not fall on Christmas Day shall be allowed, upon passage of this resolution, within Clark County.

PASSED and ADOPTED in Regular Session of the Board of Clark County Commissioners July 12, 2004.


