Applicants MUST

- Be a citizen of the United States
- Be a High School Graduate, or GED equivalent.
- Possess a valid driver's license from the state of residence.
- Be able to pass a full background check and be willing to submit to random drug testing.



Wages

- \$13.25-14.50 Depending on experience
- Full Time position is offered Insurance and retirement.
- 4 on 4 off work schedule.



Training

- The Sheriff's Office will provide on the job training to the applicant.
- Applicant will be trained in ILETS as well as State Testing.
- Applicants must pass Idaho POST for dispatchers within the first year of employment.
- Typing and computer skills are highly recommended.
