An Emergency Meeting was called on July 30, 2018 at 08:35am, located in the Clark County Commissioners Room, 224 W. Main Street, Dubois, ID 83423.

Clark County Commissioners and Emergency Management called an emergency meeting to discuss the Wildfire known as the Grassy Ridge Fire

The Disaster Declaration that was started on July 26, 2018. The declaration was declared as a result of Wildfires that threatened employment, local business, threat to life and agricultural interests including livestock, rangeland, structures, roadways, infrastructures, public utilities, and other lines of communications, and the well being of the community.


Emergency Manager Jill Egan applied and was granted the "FMAG Grant" (Fire Management Assistance Grant).

The FMAG officially ended at 09:00am on July 30, 2018.

If wildfires become a threat again the application will be resubmitted, it cannot be reopened.

The Commissioners will have a meeting to gather information about the incident to help file the paperwork for the FMAG funding. The meeting will be held on August 6, 2018 and 11:00am, in the Commissioner Meeting.
