Dear Commissioners:

Thanks for meeting with us on December 1, 2005, to discuss snow plowing on the A-2 road, from Kilgore to Mud Creek, (Mud Creek Timber Sale), and from Kilgore North to the 026 Road, (Winslow Timber Sale). We had discussed not hauling from December 27th to December 30th. If possible we would like to haul over these four days. We have approximately 650 loads decked in the woods. We plan on hauling these to Dubois and decking until spring, then hauling them to Deer Lodge. If left in the woods it would be June or July before we could haul. The mill will need the logs before then.

Other items discussed:

- Snow will be removed from the full road surface and turnouts plowed out.
- A temporary road barricade (provided by Clark County) will be placed where the county quits plowing. We will post a sign saying: ROAD CLOSED, NO PUBLIC ACCESS, NOT COUNTY MAINTAINED.
- No track equipment will be used to remove snow.
- No hauling on week-ends.

Thanks for your consideration. We appreciate you allowing us to plow snow.
