RESOLUTION NO. 05-08

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INCREASING THE BUDGET FOR THE AMBULANCE FUND "A" CATEGORY TO MEET EXPENDITURES NECESSARILY INCURRED, BUT NOT PROVIDED FOR IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2005 BUDGET. THE AMBULANCE DEPARTMENT RECEIVED GRANT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF IDAHO GENERATING REVENUES NOT ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE 2005 BUDGET. THESE FUNDS WERE USED FOR WAGES FOR A TRAINING EXERCISE PAID OUT OF THE "A" BUDGET THAT WERE ALSO NOT IN THE 2005 BUDGET.


WHEREAS: Pursuant to Idaho Code 31-1605 the County Commissioners may proceed to adjust the budget as adopted to reflect the receipt of unscheduled revenues provided that there shall be no increase in anticipated property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Clark County Board of Commissioners by a unanimous vote do hereby, order an increase in the Ambulance Fund as follows:
