

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
CLARK COUNTY, IDAHO

September 11, 1995

The Board met this day in regular session. Present were Commissioners: Charles R. Vadnais Steven R. Gilger and Charles E, Wilson, Prosecuting Attorney Craig Simpson and Clerk Jo Ann S. Tavenner.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Commissioner Gilger, seconded by Commissioner Wilson unanimous that the minutes for August 14, 1995 are hereby approved as written.

UPDATE ON PC WITH LAZER PRINTER

Harold Wilson, Planning & Zoning and Bonnie Burns County Treasurer met with the Commissioners concerning purchasing a PC pentium with lazer jet printer and scanner. Wilson said that Planning & Zoning is going in on the above mentioned equipment which would now cost \$8664. Wilson said he would come up with \$5000 and Bonnie would need to come up with \$4000. After some discussion a motion was made by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Gilger unanimous that Wilson and Burns get separate bids on the above mentioned equipment. Harold also ask permission of the commission to approve a couple of building permits. He said that Don Burtenshaw is building a couple of cabins in the Kilgore area and did not realize that Clark County had an ordinance and was ready to pour cement. and the other would be on Blaine Larsen for a couple of spud cellars. Wilson stated that neither party is in the flood zone.

After some discussion it was unanimous that Harold Wilson is hereby authorized to sign building permits for Burtenshaw and Larsen. The group also discussed updating the planning & zoning ordinance which is need to protect the county and its citizens from lawsuits. They discussed the high density and low density areas, wetlands roads etc which they al feel needs brought up to date. Wilson will try to have Lee Nelious met with the Commissioners at their next meeting.

CANCELLATION OF DELINQUENT SOLID WASTE CHARGE

Joann Abbott met with the Commissioners concerning a balance of \$34.00 that she owed on solid waste. Abbott claims she had renters move out during the winter and they still paid the county while they were cleaning up the trailer in the amount of \$64,00. After some discussion a motion was made by Commissioner Gilger, seconded by Commissioner Wilson, unanimous that the clerk is authorized to give Joann Abbott a credit in the amount of \$34.00.

OPENING OF BIDS

The Commissioners having called for bids on selling of one 1987 740A Champion motor grader with v-plow and snow wing to be opened at this time. Two bids were received:

bid bonds were included with both bids.

Motion by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Gilger, unanimous that Steven L. Matkin of Victor is hereby awarded the bid with a high bid of \$27,000.

ROAD/BRIDGE UPDATE

Rod Belcher, Road & Bridge Supervisor met with the Commissioners to update them on his department. Rod said he's had a request to purchase a used 12' section of cattlegard for \$500 or a short section for \$250. After some discussion it was unanimous that Belcher should advertise these items for sale. He also reported he needs to put in a culvert on the Montevue road to Larsen's Farm before they oil the Montevue road.

XEROX 2515 FOR ASSESSOR

Betty Kirkpatrick, Assessor met with the Commission concerning Xerox 2515 machine she had Bonneville Blueprint demonstrate in May to the Commission. Kirkpatrick said her office really needs the equipment and she has the money in her budget. Motion by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Gilger unanimous that Betty is hereby authorized to purchase Xerox machine.

CONTRACT AWARDED TO CREZEE

The Commission at this time after receiving approval on the Dave Crezee from the City of Dubois hereby award Dave Crezee the bid in the amount of \$23,322.00 on the joint County/City building. Crezee must meet all building specifications.

REVIEW OF LAND TO BE TRADED

After some discussion on land trade between Birch Creek Ranches and the State Land Board and BLM the Board decided to write letter concerning the above exchange to BLM and the Department of Lands.

COMMUNITY BUILDING OVERSEER RESIGNS

Commissioner Steven R. Gilger said for personal reasons he is resigning as overseer of the Community Building. After a short discussion it was unanimous that Gilger's resignation is accepted and the building is to be turned over to the Fair Board. Gilger will notify the Fair Board.

1996 BUDGETS APPROVED & SALARIES SET

Budgets were set for fiscal year 1995. The board reviewed and set the budget and levies for 1996.

Motion by Commissioner Gilger, seconded by Commissioner Wilson unanimous, that the budget hearing, having been held and there being no one protesting the advertised budget on September 6, 1995, this board adopted the following as the final budget for the fiscal year 1996. The salaries for 1996 will be **increased** as follows:
