

**CLARK COUNTY, IDAHO
RESOLUTION NO. 11-13**

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS
AUTHORIZED BY THE "SECURE RURAL SCHOOLS AND COMMUNITIES ACT"

WHEREAS, Congress, as part of the Secure Rural Communities and Self-Determination Act of 2008, authorized the expenditure of a portion of allocated funds under Title III of the legislation, and

WHEREAS, as of fiscal year 2008, these funds could be expended only as reimbursement for costs incurred by the county's Search and Rescue unit on federal lands, or to develop a Community Wildfire Protection Plan, or for activities establishing or implementing Firewise Communities, and

WHEREAS, a portion of the funds committed to Title III by Clark County since that time remain unspent, and

WHEREAS, the legislation specifically requires that these Title III funds be allocated for specific activities,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that all remaining Title III funds from fiscal years 2008 and later shall be spent for reimbursement to search and rescue for searches that were performed on Federal lands and purchasing two way GPS radios to be utilized by search and rescue for searches that will be performed on Federal lands. All such funds shall be spent by September 30, 2012.




