RESOLUTION NO. 04-04

WHEREAS Clark County received federal funding for an additional law enforcement officer, and

WHEREAS Clark County hired an additional officer and received federal funding to pay a portion of this officer's wages for three years, and

WHEREAS it was the County's practice to receipt the funding into a trust called "FASCOP", and then transfer the funding to current expense as it was expended, and

WHEREAS all federal funding for the "FASCOP" program was audited by the county outside auditor and annual reporting was sent into the federal government regarding these funds, and


WHEREAS there is a remaining balance of \$3611.06 in the "FASCOP" trust account held by Clark County, and

WHEREAS it is believed that these funds were never transferred to current expense fund to reimburse the account for actual wages paid to the designated "FASCOP" law enforcement officer,


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved and declared by the Clark County, Idaho, Board of Commissioners that the amount of \$3611.06 be transferred to the Clark County Current Expense fund for use by the sheriff for expenditures to operate his office.
