TREASURER UPDATE

Treasurer Lana Schwartz came before the Board with Resolution 2022-07. A discussion was had at the previous meeting on May 9, 2022. This resolution would provide relief for taxpayers who had fallen behind on payments and would reward them for making regular payments by removing interest charges while payments were continually being made.

Commissioner Hillman made a motion to accept the Treasurer's resolution 2022-07 for tax interest relief. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion and with a unanimous vote, the resolution was approved by motion.

COMMISSIONER COMMITTEE UPDATES

Commissioner Shenton briefed the Board on committee updates. Commissioner Ward updated the Board on the Waste District. Commissioner Hillman didn't have any updates at that time.

PUBLIC HEARING ON LANDFILL FEES

A hearing was opened at the Clark County Courthouse in the Commissioner's room for the price increase and addition to the county landfill fees. Present at the hearing were Commissioners Shenton, Hillman, and Ward, Clerk Messick, and Road and Bridge Supervisor Jake Irick. No members of the public were present. No feedback from the public were received by any present members. Jake noted the particular changes in the fees and discussion was had. At 10:10 am, Commissioner Shenton opened for motion to approve.

Commissioner Ward made a motion to approve the new solid waste tire and trailer fees. Commissioner Hillman seconded the motion. After a unanimous vote, the motion was approved and the public hearing was closed.
