Commissioner Hillman made a motion to approve and extend contracts for conflict attorneys through fiscal year 2023 with changes to one contract to adjust the end date to the end of the fiscal year, September 30, 2023. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion and after a unanimous vote, the motion was passed.
