March 14, 2022

**CLAIMS**

The BOCC reviewed the county claims and had a discussion regarding the expenditures for the past month.

**Commissioner Ward motioned to approve and sign last month's meeting minutes with corrections to the date. Commissioner Ward seconded the motion. Motion was passed unanimously.**

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**APPRAISER AGREEMENT RENEWAL**

Assessor Carrie May and Jeramy Dixon, the contracted appraiser with Rocky Mountain Services, LLC came forward to seek approval for a contract renewal. The agreement was reviewed and had no proposed changes from the previous contract.

**Commissioner Ward made a motion to renew the agreement for appraisal services with Rocky Mountain Services, LLC. Commissioner Hillman seconded the motion and the motion was passed unanimously without further discussion.**

**MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

Assessor May presented a Memorandum of Agreement from the Idaho Parks and Recreation to reinstate vendor rights to sell parks and recreation stickers in Clark County. The assessor's office will be closed on March 29 from 12-4 pm for training on this service from the Idaho Parks and Recreation department.

**Commissioner Ward made a motion to accept the Memorandum of Agreement with the Idaho Parks and Recreation with Clark County. Commissioner Hillman seconded the motion and after no further discussion, the motion was passed unanimously.**

**NEW BANKING INSTITUTION**

Treasurer Schwartz brought for a resolution to open a new warrant account with Idaho Central Credit Union. Some of the benefits of using ICCU are that there will be no monthly fees and interest will be earned. A discussion was held on possibly seeking insurance through the bank to cover amounts above the \$250,000 federally insured amount. The credit union also expressed an interest in investing and being involved in the community through community outreach and involvement in community events.

**Commissioner Ward made a motion to approve the resolution 2022-03 to accept ICCU as a new banking institution for Clark County. Commissioner Hillman seconded the motion and after unanimous vote, the motion was approved.**

**ROAD & BRIDGE UPDATE**

Jake Irick, Road and Bridge Supervisor came before the board to provide a monthly update for the R&B Department. Quotes were presented for seal coating costs. BOCC was in agreement with crews moving forward with the crack sealing projects.

Aaron Swenson came before the board to present agreement discussions with LHTAC regarding transportation plan. Discussion was also held regarding correspondence with Cannon Builders.
