## **MINUTES FOR BUDGET HEARING SEPTEMBER 6, 2022**

The BOCC met this day to conduct a Budget Hearing and to adopt the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget for Clark County. In attendance were Commissioners Greg Shenton and MaCoy Ward, Deputy Clerk Katie Cross, Assessor Carrie May and Clerk Camille Messick via Zoom. The Hearing was held at the Clark County Courthouse.

The meeting was called to order at 5:25 pm. No members of the public were present at the meeting. Input was asked for from the attendees. None was given. A discussion was held. It was noted that Notice of the Hearing was published in the papers with the proposed FY23 Budget showing the amount of \$8,309,575.55. Legal notice was shown at the Hearing. The Clerk confirmed that there were no questions or input from the public during the budgeting process.

There was a discussion about the 3% raise for all employees and elected officials. The average of elected officials' salaries would be figured for across the board raises at an equal amount. No more discussion was needed.

Commissioner Ward made a motion to approve the 2022-2023 budget as advertised, knowing that the elected officials' (but the coroner) salaries would be set as an average of all wages combined. Commissioner Shenton seconded the motion and the motion passed, approving the FY23 Budget. Commissioner Ward and Shenton voted an "aye" to pass the FY23 Budget.
